Information to the Bidders and Terms of reference for the Request for Proposal for engagement of consultant/architect for preparation of Eco-TourismProject in Telangana

1. Back ground:

The Telangana Forest Development Corporation Ltd., (TGFDCL) is undertaking several ecotourism projects across various parts of the state to promote sustainable tourism and enhance environmental awareness. These projects include the development of eco-friendly structures and components that are tailored to the specific needs of ecotourism and conservation. In this connection, as part of this, the TGFDC has now decided for preparing Details Project Report through reputed Architect cum consultants for effective development of infrastructure in the Amaragiri Circuit of Amrabad Tiger Reserve following environmentally sustainable practices. The TGFDC Ltd., invites applications from reputed Architects/ Architectural Consultants having sound technical background, appropriate registrations and pre-qualification criteria set out in this document and having experience in various infrastructure work particularly related to Eco-Tourism sector and its Architectural design etc., for preparation of Detailed Project Report for Eco- friendly infrastructure development in about (1) No. Nature destination, the list of which is annexed at Annexure – I.

2. Scope of work and Deliverables:

The successful Architect cum Consultants shall have to prepare Detailed Project Report in respect of architectural designing, structural designing, preparation of estimates, Tender document (DTP) for the infrastructure to be newly built and periodic supervision etc., for execution of work in relation to existing Nature Destination as per enclosed list annexed at Annexure – I. The concept, design and development of various infrastructures should be in keeping with the spirit of the Telangana culture and its natural environment. The infrastructure should include Stay facility with minimum 16 premium nature centric cottages preferably mud based or any other sustainable material, modern Environment Education Center, providing boating facility (Jetty) to reach the site as the proposed site is an island etc., Further, the designs to be in accordance with provisions of Forest WL Acts and Rules. The above details are not exhaustive but could include other components keeping in line with the environmental requirement of the areas in question. A schematic proposal for necessary guidance in this regard is enclosed as Annexure – X. The bidder will be required to make a presentation on the concept design of infrastructure before the tender evaluation committee as mentioned in the para. A concept design is to be developed by the Consultant in respect of the site. On approval of the same by the competent authority i.e., TGFDC, She/ He will prepare DPR in respect of site development (if any) landscaping design, drawing, design, estimates etc., for the proposed semi-permanent buildings/huts/ temporary shed/tenting structure etc., along with the tender schedule. The consultant/ Architect shall have to assist and coordinate with TGFDC officials in floating the tender for execution of work on GEM/ e-procurementplatform or any other process as decided by TGFDC. The successful bidder shall provide consulting services to guide the executing agency from time to time, as per requirement so that the completed work satisfy to the desired quality and matches the design and drawing submitted by the consultant.

The Architect/ consultant will provide consultancy services for:

- Stay facilities with Eco-Friendly, non-permanent structures preferably durable mud houses or with any other sustainable material at Nadimthippa Island near Amargiri Village.
- b) Boating facilities will be provided between Somasilla and Amaragiri and adjoining areas for commuting to the site.
- c) Development of infrastructure at the destination and its value addition.
- d) The concept, design, development etc., of various infrastructures should be in keeping with the spirit of the Telangana culture and its natural environment and should be site specific.
- e) Preparation of plans, estimates, detailed structural and drawing designs of the approved structures, drawing design of the interiors, furnishing fittings, decor etc.,
- f) The successful bidder will make site visit and prepare sketch map, concept drawing, layout plan etc.,

3. Eligibility:

The Architect/ Consultant should have following minimum eligibility criteria

- a. The intending Architect/ Consultant should be registered with Indian Institute of Architecture/ Council of Architecture.
- b. The intending Architect/consultant should be associated with a well-established and professionally managed organizational set up and should have **minimum 5 years experiences** in the field of providing architectural / consultancy services for infrastructure development works/ Tourism works.
- c. The Architect/consultant who has executed **at least 3 infrastructural development projects** during last 5 years relating to tourism and hospitality sectors would be given preference.
- d. The intending Architect/consultant or the firm in which the Architect is associated should have minimum turnover of **Rs.25 lakhs** in preceding 3 years ending 2024-25. (Attach Audited Accounts)
- e. The consultant should have Post Graduate Diploma in Architecture/ B. Arch or B.E/B. Tech in Civil Engineering from recognized institution.

Proof for fulfillment of eligibility criteria mentioned in the RFP document should be submitted. If the application is submitted without valid documents or is not in the prescribed formats the application will be rejected.

4. Instructions to Bidders

- **4.1** Pursuant to the aforesaid, Bids are invited on the e-procurement platform for **the Project** from the eligible Bidders.
- **4.2** Bidders are advised to study the RFP Document carefully. Submission of bid shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the RFP duly understanding of its implications. The RFP should be submitted as per the Procedure for Submission of Bids of this document not later than the date and time laid down.

4.7 Submission of Documents towards Technical Tender

- a) Documents listed in the condition No.4.5 shall be submitted, towards technical part of the tender.
- b) TGFDC shall not be responsible in any way for any failure of the Bidders with regard to submission of the Bids using the e-procurement online system.
- c) Amendments/Corrigendum, if any, will be notified only in website i.e., https://tender.telangana.gov.in and also TGFDC official website at https://fdc.telangana.gov.in/.

4.8 Opening and Evaluation of Bids

- Documents that are uploaded on e-procurement platform on or before the Bid Due Date and time duly fulfilling the bid requirements in accordance with this Tender Document shall only be considered for Bid evaluation. The Evaluation shall be strictly based on the documents uploaded on e-procurement platform only.
- Incomplete tenders & unsigned tender forms or non-submission of the same will be summarily rejected. Tenders submitted with any pre-condition or additional conditions other than the conditions prescribed and supplied by the TGFDC will also be summarily rejected.
- Tenders will be opened by the TGFDC or its nominee on the dates mentioned, unless extended by a notification published in TGFDC and e-procurement portal website.
- 4. Prior to Technical evaluation of Bids, the TGFDC will determine whether the Bid is accompanied by the required EMD.
- 5. Bids shall be considered responsive only if:
 - a) It is received by the Bid Due Date including any extension thereof.
 - b) Contains no false or misleading information or statement or undertaking
- Other documents submitted towards technical tender will be opened and checked for all the mandatory documents duly signed as per the list provided above. TGFDC shall take a decision at its sole discretion with regard to tenders without any of the said documents submitted in any other format other than the prescribed.
- 7. TGFDC reserves the right to seek further information / Clarifications from any of the bidder on the submitted documents only and the same shall be sought through a written communication/ email.

4.9 Evaluation of Price/ Financial Tenders:

- 1. TGFDC will evaluate and compare the price Tenders of all the technically qualified Bidders only. Negotiations at any level are strictly prohibited.
- 2. Evaluation of financial tenders shall be in accordance with the condition Nos. 3 & 4.5.
- 3. In the event that three or more Bidder(s) bids are computed/determined to have the same annual Concession fee quotes (the "Tie Bidders"), the TGFDC shall identify the highest bidder by draw of lots, which shall be conducted, with prior notice, in the presence of the Tie Bidders who choose to attend.
- 4. Project Cost Below Rs. 5.00 Crores (Includes furniture, interiors, kitchen setup, and all requirements)
- 5. Consultancy Services Charges not more than 3% of the total project value.

5. General Terms and Conditions

(i) Costs of preparations and submission of bids

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid, including cost of presentation for the purposes of clarification of the bid, if so desired by TGFDC Ltd. TGFDC Ltd., will in no case be responsible or liable for the above-mentioned *costs*, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Tendering process.

(ii) TGFDC Right to Terminate

TGFDC may terminate the RFP process at any time and without assigning any reason. The TGFDC makes no commitment, expressed or implied that this process will result in a business transaction with anyone. This EoI does not constitute an offer by the TGFDC. The bidder's participation in thisprocess may result in TGFDC selecting the bidder to engage in further discussions and negotiations towards execution of a contract. The commencement of such negotiations does not, however, signify a commitment by TGFDC to execute a contract or to continue negotiations. TGFDC may terminate negotiations at any time without assigning any reasons. TGFDC reserves the right not to accept any bid, and to annul the Tender process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or anyobligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of this action.

(iii) Amendment of RFP Document

At any time prior to the last date for receipt of bids, TGFDC, may, for any reason. Whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the Eol Document by an amendment. This amendment will be notified on TGFDC website i.e., https://tender.telangana.gov.in and also TGFDC official website at https://fdc.telangana.gov.in/.

(iv) Financial bid

The prices quoted shall be inclusive of all expenses including but not limited to those related with the visits of Bidder's Personnel in connection with the scope of work. The prices quoted must be firm and final and shall remain constant throughout the period of the contract and shall not be subject to any upward modifications, on any account whatsoever. Works contract tax and other charges as may be applicable in relation to the activities proposed to be carried out. Any upwardrevision in taxes in future shall not be accepted.

The Financial Bid must be specified as not exceeding 3% of the total project value. Any financial bid exceeding this 3% threshold will not be accepted.

(v) Period of Validity of Bids

Bids shall remain valid for 90 days after the date of opening of Financial Bids. TGFDC may request the Bidders for an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses there to shall be made in writing (or by email). The validity of bid security provided shall also be suitably extended.

(vi) Address for Correspondence

The Bidder shall designate the official mailing address, email, place, Phone number and Mobile number to which all correspondence shall be sent by TGFDC.

(vii) Contacting TGFDC

Any effort by a Bidder to influence TGFDC's bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decisions may result in the rejection of the Bidder's bid.

(viii) Opening of Bids

The Bids shall be opened by the Bid Evaluation committee on the decided date & time in the presence of the representatives of the consultants who may like to attend. The financial bids of only those Bidders shall be opened who qualify technically.

(ix) The Evaluation of Bids

The bids shall be evaluated by the Bid Evaluation Committee. However, TGFDC reserves the right to modify the evaluation process at any time during the Tendering process, without assigning any reason, whatsoever and without any requirements of intimating the Bidders of any such change. TGFDC has the right to seek any clarifications from the bidders. The technical bid will be reviewed for determining the eligibility of the Bidder for the Project and to ascertain Compliance of the Technical bids with the RFP terms and conditions, technical requirements and scope of work as defined in this Eol.

(x) Basis of Evaluation

A Combined Quality and Cost Based Selection forms the basis of evaluation of Technical and Financial bids. The bids shall be evaluated by a Tender Committee which will determine the weightage to be given to different parameters. The Scoring parameters to be used for Technical evaluation would be broadly as follows:

Minimum qualifying marks 70%

Each Technical bid will be assigned a technical score out of a maximum of 100 points. The bidders who score a Technical score of 70% or more i.e. 70 points or more out of 100 will be shortlisted for the evaluation of their financial bid. In case of financial bids, for completeness and accuracy, arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis: If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail.

(xi) Determining the highest scoring bidder with combined quality and cost score the evaluated bid score shall be obtained by weighing the quality and cost scores and adding them. The weight for the cost' shall be 30%, while that of the technical quality shall be 70%, taking into account the complexity of the assignment and the relative importance of quality. The following exampleshows how the combined evaluation shall be carried out to determine the evaluated bid score:

(xii) Presentation before the Bid Evaluation Committee

As a part of the technical evaluation of the bids, the bidders would be required to make a presentation before the Tender Evaluation committee. The presentation should highlight the consultants' concept and methodology, qualifications and experience of the key personnel and organizational details and other points mentioned in the Project Implementation Plan. The

presentation should not normally exceed 15 minutes with 10 minutes for clarifications by the Bid Evaluation Committee. The venue of presentation is at Conference Hall TGFDC Ltd., Botanical Garden, Masjidbanda, Kothaguda RF, Hyderabad 500 084. The date and time of presentation is on 01.03.2024 from 12.00 PM onwards. The bidders shall bear the costs related to the presentation.

6. Signing of Contract

Within 7 working days of receipt of the work order, the successful Bidder shall sign and date the Contract on a non-judicial stamp paper of value not less than Rs.100/- as per the format to be provided by TGFDC. The format of the contract will be provided to the successful bidder for his perusal and agreement.

7. Performance Bank Guarantee:

Within 7 working days of the receipt of work order from the TGFDC, the successful Bidder shall furnish the Performance Bank Guarantee from any nationalized public sector bank drawn in favour of Vice Chairman & Managing Director TGFDC Ltd., as per the format to be provided, to TGFDC which shall be equal to 10% of the value of the contract. The validity of Performance Bank Guarantee shall be till 30 days beyond the expiry of contract period.

8. Penalty:

A penalty of Rs. 500/- per day subject to a maximum of 30 days / Rs.15,000/- shall be imposed on the Bidder in the event of slippage in the delivery of the deliverables mentioned in the Eol document. The penalty amount will be adjusted in the bill at the time of payment. In case of substantial failure in performance beyond rectification, TGFDC reserves the right to forfeit the performance bank guarantee and also appoint another Architect /consulting consultant to complete the pending project at the cost of the Architect/ consulting consultant.

9. Limitation of Liability:

The total aggregate liability of the Architect / consulting consultant arising out of this contract will be limited to 100% of the total cost of the contract.

10. Sub-contracting:

The Architect/ contracted Architectural consultant agency will not be allowed to sub-contract the work to any third agency.

11. Rejection Criteria:

Besides other conditions and terms highlighted in the RFP document a bid may be rejected under following circumstances:

(i) General Rejection Criteria

- a) Bid security not received along with the bid.
- b) Bid and attached document do not confirm unconditional validity of the bid as prescribed in the RFP.
- c) If the information provided by the Bidder is found to be Incorrect / misleading at any stage / time during the Tendering Process.
- d) Effort by a Bidder to influence the TGFDCs bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decisions
- e) The Consultants who is black listed from any Government Dept.,/ Board Corporation/Nagarpalika/ Municipal corporation & any other department will be out rightly rejected.

(ii) Technical Rejection Criteria

- a) Technical Bid containing financial details.
- b) Revelation of Prices in any form or by any reason before opening the Financial Bid
- c) Failure to furnish all information required by the RFP Document or submission of a bid not substantiality responsive to the Eol Document in every respect.
- d) Bidder not quoting for the complete scope of Work as indicated in the RFP documents addendum (if any) and any subsequent Information given to the Bidder.
